The 11 tracks were recorded in three days. Each song was recorded from beginning to end in one take with all the musicians playing together live. This gives the listener a chance to experience the authentic spontaneous exchanges that occur between bandmembers. Every song includes a *'jam session style'* moment. For Brenda, improvisation is a true passion and has always been one of the main elements in her work.

This is the first time that Hopkins Miranda includes singers in one of her albums. There are 8 singers - all Puerto Rican – on "*Puentes*". The musical arrangements were crafted to bring out the best in each of them. Hopkins Miranda is both fan and friend of all the guest artists that collaborated with her. This is also the first time that Brenda recorded songs composed by others. Each song was chosen because it has been present in the pianist's life since childhood. Her artistic goal for this album was to provide a fresh, innovative and even unexpected sound to a group of well-known songs without altering their essence.

With "Puentes" Hopkins Miranda looks to overcome the distance that typically exists between music genres, tradition & innovation, people, languages, beliefs and generations. For the artist music is about building bridges. For Brenda Hopkins Miranda music is all about unity and LOVE.
